DIFFICULTY: EASY LENGTH: 4,5 KM

The route runs along the Pisa River. It is designed for pedestrians or cyclists.

Attractions: numerous birds, e.g. cranes, small architecture objects for tourists, halfway from Barczewo - a place called the Krzyżowa Mountain - place of worship of the ancient Prussians.

The route along the river is paved, after entering the village of Zalesie (at the height of the hotel) it is sandy. It leads through the forest to the city beach in Zalesie, where you can swim in the lake, play volleyball on the sandy playing field, work out at the outdoor gym. You can also have a picnic.

! Watch out for traffic on the section through the city.
